

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



As we embrace a new liturgical year with the Season of Advent and we look forward in hope to the coming year 2024, I would like to draw your attention to a matter of significant importance regarding our parish's future and the sustainability of our vital works and ministries. Our parish faces a considerable challenge in 2024: a forecasted 67% increase in our insurance premiums.

This substantial increase is due to *Catholic Church Insurance* (CCI) ceasing to issue new or renewal policies and voluntarily placing their organisation into "run off" - thus leading to our Diocese having to engage with a new insurer to secure insurance policies for all parishes, includes ours.

The prospect of this increase - along with the increased costs of other utilities like water and electricity - is indeed daunting, especially in a time when I know many among us are confronting financial strains due to rising interest rates and the escalating cost of living. It is in this crucial juncture that we must come together as a unified parish family to safeguard the invaluable services, ministries and activities that embody the essence of OUR VISION, and ensure that we can achieve our parish goals both in 2024 and into the future. In light of the forthcoming challenges our parish faces, I would like to extend an invitation, both to those already engaged in planned giving and to those who have yet to join.

For those of you already in planned giving, I say 'thank you'. Your consistent and generous contributions have been the cornerstone of our parish's ability to carry out its works and ministries. Your commitment truly embodies the spirit of giving and community. While I acknowledge this may not be possible for everyone, I kindly encourage those who are able to consider increasing your weekly contribution to planned giving, even if by just \$5 dollars (that it seems is now the average cost of a takeaway coffee) or another amount. Small individual increments, when combined, can create a substantial collective impact. Your willingness to consider this slight adjustment will greatly assist in ensuring the continuity and strength of our parish's mission.

To those who are not currently part of our planned giving program, I invite you to join this noble endeavor. Your participation, regardless of the amount, will significantly contribute to safeguarding our works and ministries. Even the smallest contribution can make a considerable difference when shared among our parish community.

This year our extraordinary catechists have brought the light of faith to over 1000 young parishioners in state schools across our parish. Their dedication to guiding and educating our youth in matters of faith has been nothing short of inspiring. We express our deepest gratitude to these devoted individuals whose unwavering commitment has nurtured the spiritual growth of our young parishioners. Their impact is profound, offering an opportunity for many children to explore and deepen their faith—a gift that wouldn't be possible without the tireless ministry of our catechists. Our heartfelt thanks to our catechists for their invaluable service and the profound impact they've made on the lives of our youth.

Our parish joyously relaunched Alpha in 2023, witnessing incredible registration of over 80 enthusiastic participants! Alpha isn't just a course; it's an immersive experience! Over 9-10 weeks. participants came together weekly for a shared meal, engaging talks, and meaningful discussions in small groups. This extraordinary journey brought together diverse individuals from all walks of life, fostering connections and deepening their faith.





A highlight of 2023 was the construction, blessing and opening of 'Stage 1' of our Parish Community Garden. A small project team engaged the parish community for input, planned the initial stage of construction and sought sponsorship from local businesses and government. This 'shared garden space' is a place where people can work collaboratively to grow produce, enjoy recreation in the environment and build a sense of community.

In the year 2023, our parish has witnessed incredible milestones in faith and devotion. Over 200 little ones have been baptised, embracing the loving embrace of Christ. Moreover, more than 350 young hearts received their First Holy Communion. Additionally, over 160 children have received the Sacrament of Confirmation, marking their commitment to their faith journey. Here at our parish, sacramental preparation isn't merely a program that children complete; it's a journey of encountering Jesus and His Spirit, a path toward finding their place in the Catholic Church. We strive to foster an environment where our young parishioners joyfully embrace their role as missionary disciples of Jesus, living out their faith with exuberance and love!

During 2023 our vibrant youth group for parishioners in Years 7 to 12, MacKillop Youth, has thrived, offering a space for our young high schoolers to forge new friendships and deepen their faith journey. Through shared meals, engaging games and activities, formative discussions, heartfelt prayers, and uplifiting music, these gatherings have become a haven for growth and connection. As well as gathering regularly during the school terms, MacKillop Youth led our '2023 Good Friday Stations of the Cross' and had the opportunity to 'go on pilgrimage together' to St Mary's Cathedral in Sydney. They have also had great opportunities to engage in fun activities like Indoor Bowling and to 'reach out to others' through social outreach activities.
