





# What People Value and Prioritise




Attenders of this parish most value 'Celebrating the Eucharist/receiving Holy Communion' and 'Sermons and homilies'




## **People's Gifts and Skills**




Attenders most commonly identified their gifts or skills as "Education: teach, coach" and "Hospitality: welcome, host, provide food"

### 26% want to be MORE INVOLVED at this parish






#### **GIFTS & SKILLS OF CHILDREN AT THIS CHURCH**


Children at this parish most commonly identified "Being kind to people who don't have any friends yet" and "Taking care of God's earth" as their gifts and skills.

# **How People Relate to God**









# How People Relate to the Wider Community



# Vision, Innovation and Leadership Culture




36% of people are both aware of and strongly COMMITTED TO THE VISION and goals or directions for this parish






are fully confident that this parish CAN ACHIEVE THE VISION, goals or directions set
