

LITURGY OF THE WORD

1st **READING** Isaiah 35:1-6, 10 (JB) God himself will come and save us.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM Ps 145:6-10 (JB)

R. Lord, come and save us.

2nd READING James 5:7-10 (JB): You also must be patient; do not lose heart, the Lord's coming will be soon.

GOSPEL ACCLAMATION Alleluia, alleluia!

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me;

he sent me to bring Good News to the poor. Alleluia! (Isaiah 61:1 (Luke 4:18) (JB))

GOSPEL Matthew 11:2-11 (JB): Are you the one who is to come, or must we wait for someone else?

Rejoice in the Lord always – indeed the Lord is near.

There is something in the air! You can almost feel it. It is Jesus coming to town, to our own hearts if we welcome him. The very word "Advent" means "arrival" or "coming" and Jesus is the One whose Advent or arrival or coming we are waiting for. Jesus will come to us this Christmas and we can make more room for him.

In the tradition of the Liturgical calendar, the 3rd Sunday in Advent is often called "Gaudete Sunday." 'Gaudete' is a Latin word which means 'rejoice'. Having passed the midpoint of Advent, our joy gets more and more intense as we advance in our journey of faith.

This joy is the gladness of heart that comes from knowing God and surrendering to him, knowing Jesus and trusting and abiding in him, and being guided by the inspiration and promptings of the Holy Spirit.

This joyful spirit is marked by the third candle which is 'rose coloured,' and the 'rose coloured' vestments are often used because they represent a lightening of the purple used during the season of Advent. I seem to recall that I read somewhere some time ago that the rose colour can also remind us of the colour of the sky first thing in the morning, when the sun is just beginning to come up. The horizon takes on a pale rose colour that gradually gets redder and brighter as the sun rises. For us faithful Christians, life is like a "long sunrise". This is the reason why this Sunday is also called "Rose Sunday."

On this 3rd Sunday of Advent, it is also our joy to take this opportunity to extend our heartiest congratulations to Fr Sinh Le who was ordained into the priesthood of Christ on 13 December 2025. May our loving God shower Fr Sinh Le with many blessings as he commences his priestly ministry.


THE ART OF DYING WELL – FOUR-PART SERIES

Canon lawyers present new standard work on child welfare

Myriam Wijlens and Yeshica Marianne Umaña Calderón release an English-language textbook on child welfare, drawing on a long-running interdisciplinary course at the University of Erfurt. Papal preacher: Advent is a time of trusting expectation

"The Parousia of the Lord. An expectation without hesitation" is the theme of the first of three meditations for Christmas, which began this morning, 5 December, in the Paul VI Hall, with Pope Leo in attendance.

Despite new settler attacks on Taybeh, Christians continue to hope. Two cars were set on fire and a building was defaced with a threatening message during the night between 4 and 5 December in Taybeh, a Christian village in the northern West Bank. The incident occurred only hours after the inauguration of the parish's "Christmas Nights" celebrations.

Zimbabwe: Bishops urge national renewal, compassion, and responsible stewardship in Advent. As the Church enters the sacred Season of Advent, Zimbabwe's Catholic Bishops' Conference (ZCBC) has released a Pastoral Statement titled "Advent Pastoral Message – Remember the Poor," in which it invites Zimbabweans to use the period as a time of national renewal, both social and spiritual.

Chris Pratt to present new documentary about St Peter's tomb

American actor Chris Pratt is currently filming a documentary on the Vatican Necropolis. Produced by Vatican Media, the Fabric of St Peter, and AF Films, it will be released in 2026 for the 400th anniversary of the inauguration and dedication of the Basilica.
