Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.



MESSAGE FROM OUR EMERITUS PARISH PRIEST FR DAVID

Dear Parishioners,

I want to sincerely thank you for your ongoing support and prayers since my acute myeloid leukaemia diagnosis in October.

Alongside my ongoing chemotherapy and other treatments, the team at the Kinghorn Cancer Centre, connected to St Vincent's Hospital, has been exploring the possibility of me having a stem cell transplant. While this procedure is not without risks, it offers the potential for a better prognosis.

I have completed all the necessary preliminary tests and scans in preparation for this procedure, which will require me to spend a month in isolation at the hospital. During this time, I have been told that I won't be able to have visitors or receive flowers or other gifts, but I know your prayers and thoughts will be with me, and that will give me great comfort. After my time in isolation, I will need to live close to the hospital for two months for follow-up tests and care.

I thought it would be meaningful that, as my stem cell transplant is providentially taking place close to the places where Eileen O'Connor lived and ministered, I invite you to join me in a novena to this Servant of God, beginning on the first day of my hospital admission and transplant journey, this Thursday 6 March.

While a novena traditionally lasts nine days, it would mean so much to me if you could continue praying the "novena prayer to Eileen" over the one month, while I am in isolation at the hospital.

Thank you for continuing to accompany me in prayer, especially through the intercession of our beloved patron St Mary MacKillop and Eileen O'Connor. Your faith and support mean more to me than I can express.
