Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.






We are the parish of Mary MacKillop.

CHANGES TO ACCESS TO CHURCH/PARISH OFFICE

From Monday, 10 July, to Friday, 14 July, electricians will be cutting and excavating the driveway in front of St Benedict's as part of the work to rectify the precinct carpark lights that are not working.

The northern and southern footpaths will still be open for those wishing to access the Church and Parish Office, however, people are asked to take note that they will be required to walk a further distance.
