Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.



2024 STATIONS OF THE CROSS

Of all the pious exercises connected with the Fridays of Lent, none is more popular than the Via Crucis (Stations of the Cross).

Again, this year, on each of the Fridays of Lent (beginning 16 February) you are invited to gather at 7pm at our Oran Park Mass Centre (near the Stations of the Cross).

These Stations will be led by Fr David and Deacon Sam, as well as one Stations Liturgy on Friday, 1 March, led by Deacon Isa Gorial and the Chaldean community.



PARISH PIETY STALL TO REOPEN SOON

Our Parish Piety Stall, located at our Oran Park Mass Centre, will be re-opening soon.

Each week, the stall will be open <u>after</u> the Saturday Vigil Mass and <u>after</u> all of our Sunday Masses. The Piety Stall will stock religious cards and inspirational gifts suitable for those receiving Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation. Also, the stall will sell children's religious books. Rosaries, holy cards, medals, scapulars

children's religious books, Rosaries, holy cards, medals, scapulars, Crosses, St Mary MacKillop and Eileen O'Connor themed items, Bibles, greeting cards, Sunday and Daily Missals, devotional and seasonal items, and inspirational gifts for family and friends. All proceeds will go to support our Parish ministries.

As many of the items stocked in our parish Piety Stall will relate to the sacraments and our Parish sacramental programs, our stall will from now on be coordinated by our Volunteer Sacramental Coordinator (who, with the guidance of Fr David and the support of our Parish Office administration team, will coordinate the ordering of items and the stocking of the Piety Stall cabinet). The rostering of volunteers to minister at the stall - as are our liturgical ministries - will be coordinated by our Parish Office Coordinator.

In terms of volunteers, we are now on the lookout for parishioners who might like to go on a roster to offer 1/2hr of time following a Mass to serve and sell items at the Piety Stall. We would like to secure the assistance of '4-5 people per weekend mass time', which will see those on the roster only required to minister at the stall 'after Mass once a month'. If you would like to assist, or for more information, please contact the Parish Office.

ONLINE ENROLMENTS FOR 1st RECONCILIATION/1st HOLY COMMUNION OPEN ON MONDAY 19 FEBRUARY.

Those families who wish to present their children for the Sacraments of 1st Reconciliation/1st Holy Communion in 2024 are asked to complete **the online enrolment form which will be available** through the 'Youth Sacraments' page on our Parish website from Monday, 19 February.

Online enrolments will close on Friday 8 March.

Don't forget that 1st Reconciliation and 1st Holy Communion is now a combined program of 6 weeks. So rather than families committing to one program for 1st Reconciliation and then another program for 1st Holy Communion, candidates prepare for both Sacraments at the same time. The focus of this combined program is "From Mass to Mission" that draws upon the purpose statement of our Parish "to form disciples who joyfully live out the mission of Jesus Christ". (If a child has already made their 1st Reconciliation and was just wanting to receive their 1st Holy Communion, they are still required to complete the 6-week program).

Please remember, only those who attend mass and/or reside within the Parish boundary of Oran Park are permitted to submit a sacramental enrolment form. (Please refer to the Parish website for the boundary map). Those who are parishioners of Camden, Varroville or Eagle Vale Parishes should complete sacramental preparations through their local Parish.

CLERGY APPOINTMENT

Bishop Brian Mascord has appointed Fr Feleki Tautunu (currently Assistant Priest at Campbelltown) as Assistant Priest for our Parish of St Mary MacKillop.

In this role, Fr Feleki will support Fr David with Masses and other pastoral and sacramental needs in our Parish. Fr Feleki will, for the time being, remain resident at Campbelltown Parish.

Fr Feleki was born in Apia, Samoa. He is number eight of a big family of ten (six brothers and three sisters). Fr Feleki is a Priest of the Archdiocese of Samoa-Apia. He entered the Pacific Regional Seminary in 2001 and was ordained Priest on 8 December 2007. Fr Feleki moved to Australia in 2017 and ministered in the Sydney Archdiocese, before moving to our Diocese in December 2018. He is also the chaplain for the Samoan Catholic Community in the Diocese.

Fr Feleki will begin this appointment at Oran Park on 17/18 February (1st weekend of Lent).
