Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.





1ST HOLY COMMUNION REHEARSALS

These will be held following all Masses at our Oran Park Mass Centre NEXT weekend (17/18 June). All candidates (irrespective of the school they attend) are asked to 'stay back for a 15 minute rehearsal' that will be held after the Mass. There is no need to 'pre-register' to attend one of these rehearsal.

Mass will be held on Tuesday, 13 June. As there will be 11 candidates receiving the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation, this 7pm Mass may be extended by up to 30 minutes.

2023/2024 RCIA TEAM MEMBERS

While Fr David appreciates the 2-3 parishioners – from our 2022/2023 RCIA team - who have expressed an interest in being a member of the parish RCIA team for 2023/2024, for our parish to continue this important ministry we need more people to come forward to assist. So, if in the spirit of OUR VISION as a parish you would like to share your gifts of time and talent to become a member of an RCIA team or would like to find out more, please contact Fr David, c/o the Parish Office via email or phone 46482226.

In terms of the time commitment to be involved in this ministry: RCIA team members would be required to facilitate a fortnightly gathering with enquirers on a Wednesday evening from 7pm - 9pm, between the first Wednesday of August 2023 to Easter Sunday 2024. These fortnightly gatherings would be held in the Tenison Woods Meeting Room (Oran Park), and are only be held during school terms (so there would be no commitment over any of the school holiday periods).

UPGRADE OF ORAN PARK CHURCH PA

As the numbers attending weekend Masses at Oran Park increases, we need a PA system that allows the congregation to become more engaged and focused, while also helping the Mass to run smoothly for the congregation and all ministers. So, after consulting with the Parish Finance Council and after seeking the approval of Bishop Brian, we will be upgrading the PA system. This work will be undertaken from Monday 26 June to Friday 30 June and, as such, there will be no weekday Masses at Oran Park. 1st HOLY COMMUNION MASSES

Saturday 24th June | Sunday 25th June We pray for the over 300 children who are currently preparing for the Sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Holy Communion.

1st Holy Communion Masses will be celebrated in the St Justin's/St Benedict's Hall on 24/25 June.

Our normal 'weekend Masses' will continue to be celebrated at our Oran Park and Leppington churches.

KidsChurch at 8am and 10am Masses at Oran Park

We are very excited to have KidsChurch at both 8am and 10am Masses at Oran Park.

The intentional focus is on the children experiencing the Liturgy of the Word at their level. This involves songs and hymns, prayers, Gospel reading and a reflection/discussion on the Gospel.

The activity sheet will be utilised if time permits.

KidsChurch is for Children Aged 5-8 years, that is the year before school until Year 2 (pre receiving First Holy Communion). The numbers are capped at 35 children per session. (Children who are younger than age 5 are unable to attend KidsChurch).

KidsChurch Leaders will be under the covered area outside the Parish Office with High Vis Vests and Lanyards before each Mass and can help sign up/register your children each week. Each child will receive a sticker with their names on it which helps to identify that they are attending KidsChurch for that Mass.

Once the 35 stickers have been allocated per Mass, that will be all who can attend for that week. It will be important to arrive about 15 minutes before Mass to secure your place.

ONLINE ENROLMENTS FOR CONFIRMATION 2023 OPEN THIS MONDAY

Those families who wish to prepare their children for the Sacrament of Confirmation in 2023 (which will be held on Saturday, 16th September) are asked to complete **the online Enrolment**Form which will be available from THIS Monday, 12th June, through the 'Youth Sacraments' page on our Parish website. Online enrolments will close on Friday, 30th June at 5pm.

Those children who are <u>in Yr6 and above</u>, and are baptised Catholic and have made their 1st Reconciliation and 1st Holy Communion, are able to enrol.

(To complete the online Enrolment Form, families will be required to upload a copy of their receipt for the 'Sacramental Offering' and upload a copy of their child's Baptism Certificate. More details on how to make this Sacramental Offering and how to upload both the receipt for this offering and the Baptism Certificate can be found in the opening sections of the online Enrolment Form).

Please note: Once families have enrolled and enrolments close, they will receive a 'confirmation email' with the dates/times for the compulsory Parent Information Sessions which will be held 18 and 19 July 2023. Every family **MUST** attend one of these compulsory Parent Information Sessions to collect their Candidate's workbook and other important material needed to fully participate in this sacramental preparation process.
