Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.


We are sustained by the **Sacraments** and nurtured in our faith in **Jesus Christ.**






Do you know someone who is looking for support to develop stronger relationships with themselves and their loved ones?

particular reading plan, so not only can this daily reading Bible be started at any time of year, but it will help readers follow the biblical narrative in order as they read the Scripture from start to finish. Each reading in *The NRSV Daily Bible* only takes 10 minutes per day, and many sections incorporate daily meditations from well-known Christian thinkers and writers.
