Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.



BAMBINELLI SUNDAY 4th Sunday of Advent

Since 1968, the Pope has officiated at a special ceremony in St Peter's Square during Advent. Children of Rome flock to St Peter's Piazza for the 'Midday Angelus' where the Pope blesses the figurines of the Baby Jesus brought from their homes.

While traditionally held on 'Rose Sunday', this year the blessing will take place on the 4th Sunday of Advent -21/22 December.

We ask everyone to bring your statue of Baby Jesus from your Nativity Set at home to one of our Oran Park Masses to be blessed.

Before the final blessing of the Mass, you will be invited to stand with your "Bambinelli" for the blessing and sprinkling of Holy Water.
