Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.


We are sustained by the **Sacraments** and nurtured in our faith in **Jesus Christ.**

Those families who wish to prepare their children for the Sacrament of Confirmation in 2024 (which will be held on Saturday, 21 September) are asked to complete **the online enrolment form which is now available** through the 'Youth Sacraments' page on our Parish website. Online enrolments will close on Friday 28 June at 5pm. Those children who are in Yr6 and above, and are baptised Catholic and have made their 1st Reconciliation and 1st Holy Communion, are able to enrol. To complete the online enrolment form, families will be required to upload a copy of their receipt for the 'Sacramental Offering' and upload a copy of their child's Baptism Certificate.

# Would you like to discern becoming a Catholic-Christian at Easter 2025?

You are invited to take part in our Parish RCIA program, that will begin mid-August and go through to the Easter Vigil 2025. RCIA stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. A focus of our 2024/2025 RCIA process will be fortnightly Wednesday gatherings for all RCIA enquirers from 7pm-9pm (not including the Wednesdays of the school holidays) Some have described the RCIA as a 'program to become a Catholic'. However, RCIA isn't a program, it's a process, a journey: that won't finish at the Easter Vigil next year, when those who are ready will receive the Sacraments, but will shape the course of the rest of their lives.
