Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.



MESSAGE FROM FR DAVID

Dear friends

It's hard to believe that a month has already passed since I shared the news of my Acute Myeloid Leukaemia diagnosis with you.

Although stepping away from my role as your Parish Priest was one of the hardest decisions I've had to make, please know that you are close to my heart and in my daily prayers. Each of you is a true source of strength for me, and I am profoundly grateful for your support, love, and prayers for my family and me during this time.

Throughout my treatment - which includes daily chemo tablets and a week of chemo injections every 21 days - I am facing challenging moments with fatigue, bone pain, and the need for regular blood transfusions, I am doing everything I can to stay strong, and I ask for your ongoing prayers that God will continue to sustain me in both body and spirit.

I pray especially that St. Mary MacKillop and Servant of God Eileen O'Connor will intercede for all of us. Since my treatment began a month ago, St. Mary MacKillop's words, "Trust in God's providence, which is ours today," have brought me great comfort, and I hope they bring encouragement to you as well.

Know that, despite the physical distance, I am always with you in spirit. May God's grace and peace be with you all.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF CHILDREN FOR CHILDREN WHO ARE NOT BAPTISED CATHOLIC

Children 7 years and above who are not baptised or who have been baptised in a Christian church other than Catholic, are still able to make their First Reconciliation and/or First Holy Communion, by taking part in a 5-week preparation process – prior to the start of our 1st Reconciliation/1st Holy Communion preparation program.

This preparation process, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Children (RCIC) will be an opportunity for these children, supported by their adult family members, to 'meet in a small group' to learn more about what it means to be a Catholic-Christian and to prepare for their Baptism (or for those already baptised in another Christian church, their 'Reception into the Catholic Church').

Children who journey through RCIC (and have completed the 5 week RCIC program, along with the 1st Reconciliation/1st Holy Communion program) will, as set down by liturgical practice, receive their Baptism/Reception into the Catholic Church, 1st Holy Communion and Confirmation all during the one Mass. (The RCIC Mass for 2025 will be held on Tuesday 17 June at the regular 7pm evening Parish Mass).
