Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.



UPDATE ON FR DAVID

Last weekend, at our Parish Masses, we received the update on Fr David's latest health challenge and, specifically, that he has now been diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukaemia (AML).

Due to the seriousness of both the treatment and the prognosis, Fr David has had to make the difficult discernment to resign as our Parish Priest, effective from Sunday, 13 October at 11.59pm.

Fr David would like to thank all those who, since last weekend's announcement, have sent him messages of prayer and encouragement. While, due to his treatment, Fr David is not able to respond to every message, he is very grateful for this support for him and his family.

In consultation with Fr David, who will be guided by his medical teams, we are looking at a way we as a Parish can offer a "Mass of Thanksgiving and Farewell" to acknowledge Fr David's ministry as our foundation Parish Priest and to pray for him and his family at this time.

Those wishing to contact Fr David are asked to do so via an email or letter sent to him c/o the Oran Park Parish office (oranpark@dow.org.au, PO BOX 889, Narellan NSW 2567). As his treatment has begun, Fr David is unable to access his mobile phone or email address at all times.
