Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.

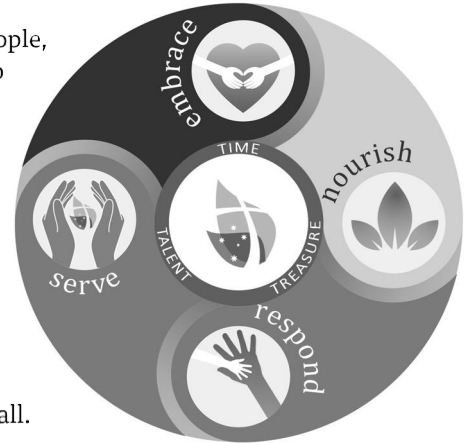
We are sustained by the **Sacraments** and nurtured in our faith in **Jesus Christ.**

As we have limited space for storing your generous donations, we ask any items be brought to Church over 2 designated weekends:

24-25 August

We will have containers available on these two dates, together with envelopes clearly marked ESCABAGS, at both our Leppington and Oran Park Churches.

UPCOMING FEAST DAYS

On Thursday, 8 August, we celebrate the Feast Day of St Mary MacKillop, our Parish Patron.

We will commemorate this Feast Day over the weekend of 3-4 August and a Morning Tea will be held following our 10am weekday Mass on Thursday, 8 August.

Also, on 15 August, we celebrate the Feast Day of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. **This day is a ‘Holy Day of Obligation’ (and holds the same status/rank as a Sunday)**

We will be holding a 7pm Vigil Mass on Wednesday, 14 August, at Leppington; and two Masses (10am and 7pm) on Thursday, 15 August, at Oran Park.

WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS & THE ELDERLY

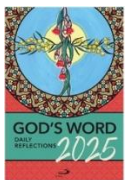
