Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.



TRIBUNAL OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

In 2015, Pope Francis wrote that "charity and mercy demand that the Church, like a good mother, be near her children who feel themselves estranged from her."

The Inter-diocesan Tribunal of Sydney, which has an Office in the Diocese of Wollongong, is a service of the Church to assist with the pastoral care of Catholics and non-Catholics who are civilly divorced, and who are seeking to remarry or who want clarification of their standing in the Church.

The Tribunal also assists remarried persons seeking to have their current marriage recognised in the Church, and remarried persons wishing to be baptised or received into the Catholic Church. Any divorced person, or a divorced and remarried person is welcome to contact the Wollongong Office of the Tribunal to obtain further information, or to have their status within the Church clarified.

JOURNEY TO PENTECOST

If you are an adult Catholic, who has previously received the Sacrament of Baptism but have not received the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation, consider joining us in preparing to receive these Sacraments.

In 2025 we will once again be adding a special process for adult First Holy Communion/Confirmation preparation to our Parish Calendar.

This process, called **'Journey to Pentecost'**, will be held over 4 weekly evening sessions, beginning in May 2025, and see adult candidates receive the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and/or Confirmation at the Vigil Mass of Pentecost on Saturday, 7 June 2025.

On behalf of the President (Pat O'Flynn), Conference Members and those we assist, thank you for the incredible support the Camden/Oran Park Conference received from St. Justin's Primary School and St Benedict's High School in the lead-up to Christmas with Hampers and toys. And from fellow Parishioners and the Parish Young Adults after Christmas with groceries and foodstuffs which we used to replenish our pantry in the Outreach Cottage in Camden.

We assist people who are experiencing hardship with emergency relief, money management and referral. In the past two years since the Outreach Cottage opened, we have seen an increasing number of people in need due to the increased cost of living - primarily due to rent and mortgage stress, medical specialists, and domestic violence. And sadly, most of our referrals are from Oran Park.
