Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.



DO SOMETHING SUNDAY | May - June

Our next bi-monthly "Do Something Sunday" for MAY-JUNE will be an opportunity for our parish to reach out to the nearly two million people who are internally displaced because of the recent earthquake disaster and a decade and more of civil war in Syria. The Christian population has been particularly devastated with little aid and support getting to Christian areas. Bishop Robert Rabbat, the Eparch of the Melkite Church in Australia has established an appeal specifically for the people of Syria. He says, "As time passes and the media pack moves on, the suffering survivors remain with nowhere to go, seemingly without hope, without a future. The greatest tragedy, one even greater than the earthquake itself, would be for them to think they have been forgotten"

While you can donate to this May-June "Do Something Sunday" focus through the special collection boxes located at both our Mass Centres, with so many people using cashless payment methods, we will also focus one our TAP&GO machines (located in our Oran Park Mass Centre) to be a cashless offering point (during May and June) for this Appeal.
