Sharing the sacred land of the Dharawal people, the parish of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop at Leppington and Oran Park is a family of diverse families.


We are sustained by the **Sacraments** and nurtured in our faith in **Jesus Christ.**

We are a parish that **responds** to the needs of our neighbours, wherever they may be.




We are the parish of Mary MacKillop.
